WHEREAS, Assistant Chief Joel Bryden will take over as Chief of Police for the City of Walnut Creek on June 30, 2008; and

WHEREAS, Walnut Creek has a population of 66,000 residents and a police force of seventy-eight sworn officers and thirty-nine civilian employees; and

WHEREAS, over his tenure with the City of San Diego, Assistant Chief Joel Bryden was in charge of Centralized Investigations, which includes homicide, gangs, robbery, sex crimes, vice, narcotics and the laboratory; and

WHEREAS, prior to his current assignment, Assistant Chief Joel Bryden managed the San Diego Police Department's Special Operations Bureau, which includes SWAT, K-9, Air Support, Special Events and Traffic Operations; and

WHEREAS, during his twenty-eight years with the San Diego Police Department, Assistant Chief Joel Bryden was the Commanding Officer of the SWAT unit and the Captain in charge of the Southeastern and Central Area stations; and

WHEREAS, Assistant Chief Joel Bryden was also in charge of planning and operations for the 2003 Super Bowl, held in San Diego; and


