## Leash-Free Dog Park Rules and Regulations

1. Operating Hours: The Park will be open for use from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
2. No person or dog shall remain in the Park during non-operating hours.
3. The Park is for use by dogs and their owners or handlers and those persons accompanying the owners or handlers.
4. Dogs must be leashed when entering or leaving the Park.
5. Dogs must be accompanied and closely supervised by their owners or handlers at all times while in the Park. Dogs must never be left unattended by their owners or handlers.
6. Children and infants must be closely supervised at all times while in the Park and must never be left unattended. Children are not allowed to run, shout, scream, wave their arms, or otherwise excite the dogs while in the Park.
7. Dog owners and handlers must have dog leash in hand at all times for each dog while in the Park.
8. Dogs must be under effective voice control of their owners or handlers while in the Park.
9. Dogs that are aggressive, officially declared “dangerous dogs,” in heat, or sick are not allowed in the Park.
10. Equipment in the Park is for dog use only. Children are not allowed to climb on the equipment.
11. All dogs using the Park must have current vaccinations and current license. Dog license and identification tags must be attached to the dog’s collar while in the Park.
12. For the safety of users of the Park, spike collars are not allowed on dogs in the Park.
13. Dogs that are or become aggressive while in the Park must immediately be removed from the Park.
14. Dog owners and handlers must clean up after their dogs while in the Park and properly dispose of waste.

15. Digging by the dogs in the Park is not allowed. Dog owners and handlers must immediately stop their dogs from digging and are responsible for filling in any holes that their dogs create.
16. No Smoking, alcoholic beverages, glass containers, food or dog treats are allowed in the Park.
17. No strollers, carriages, bicycles or children's toys are allowed in the Park.
18. No dog training, agility or obedience classes may be conducted in the Park.
19. Use of the Park is a voluntary activity. Users of the Park do so at their own risk and assume the risk of any and all personal injury or property damage associated with or resulting from the use of the Park. Dog owners and handlers are legally responsible for their dogs and liable for any and all injuries or damage caused by their dogs.
20. The Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, the City of San Diego and the Centre City Development Corporation, Inc. shall not be liable for any injury, damage, or illness to any dog, owner, handler or visitor or for any damage to their property.
21. The use of the Park by dog owners and handlers shall constitute: (i) agreement by the owners and handlers to follow the Park Rules and Regulations, (ii) a waiver of liability of the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, the City of San Diego and the Centre City Development Corporation, Inc., and (iii) agreement to protect, indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, the City of San Diego and the Centre City Development Corporation, Inc. from any claim, injury or damage arising from or in connection with such use.
22. The Park is subject to closure without notice.
23. The Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego reserves all rights to modify and enforce the Park Rules and Regulations.
