The following four candidates were selected by the Councilmembers on the first round of balloting: Susan Golding, Robert Magness, Peter B. Stafford, and Rachel M. Wong, with a three-way tie between William J. Brierton, Jr., Ben Elliott, and Gloria D. McColl.

The following two candidates were selected by the Councilmembers on the second round of balloting: William J. Brierton, Jr., and Gloria D. McColl.

Mayor Wilson announced that the final selection would be made at the Special Council Meeting, 2:00 p.m., Friday, January 23, 1981.
