- a. Revising tandem parking regulations;
  - b. Adding joint use and common parking regulations;
  - c. Adding Coastal Zone regulations relating to off-street parking.
- 5) - Amend Chapter X, Article 1, Division 9 by making several technical revisions to the Planned Residential Development regulations and adding Coastal Zone regulations thereto;
- 6) - Amend Chapter X, Article 1, Division 11 by adding Coastal Zone regulations to the On-Premises Sign Ordinance.
