CITY ATTORNEY COMMENT:

City Attorney Gwinn commented on the decision of the United States Supreme Court in the case of United States v. Oakland Cannabis Buyers Cooperative where the Supreme Court by an 8 to 0 vote ruled against the ability of states or local jurisdictions to have some type of medical-necessity exception for marijuana as a Schedule 1 federal drug. City Attorney Gwinn commented that now we have the same dynamic of what cities and counties should be doing in California given this decision. City Attorney Gwinn said that a report would be prepared and available for the City Council probably within 10 days. Mayor Murphy commented that the Medical Marijuana Task Force is on the docket for next week.
