SUBJECT: Council District Seven Vacancy

By memorandum of October 14, 1985, you asked what is the earliest possible date the newly elected council member for District Seven (7) could be sworn in.

The term of council members is specifically provided in San Diego City Charter section 12 to be a four (4) year term "from and after 10 a.m. the first Monday after the first day of December next succeeding their election ...."

The commencement of the term is echoed in San Diego Municipal Code section 27.2020 which provides:

SEC. 27.2020 TERM OF OFFICE

The term of office for officers elected at a primary or general election pursuant to this

article shall commence at 10:00 o'clock a.m.

(local time) on the first Monday after the first day in December following their election or upon the taking of their oath of office, whichever event occurs later. The term of office for officers elected at a special election pursuant to this article shall commence at the time the Council adopts the resolution declaring the results of such election.

Therefore under the requirements of the above provisions, the earliest date for filling the vacancy in District Seven (7) would be December 2, 1985 at 10:00 a.m. (local time).
