SUBJECT: Extension of Pump Station 64 Emergency

Ordinance

By a recent brief memorandum, you inquired about the legal requirements of extending the emergency ordinance dealing with Pump Station 64.

Under Council direction this office prepared the attached emergency ordinance that by its terms expires on July 29, 1986. This termination date was specified by the Council. Should the Council desire to continue the ban on building permits in this geographical area, the Council can direct the City Attorney to prepare another emergency ordinance under San Diego City Charter section 17 dealing with the same subject matter.

A regular or non-emergency ordinance would not be possible to continue the ban without interruption since such ordinances can be passed only after twelve (12) calendar days have elapsed between introduction and final passage. San Diego City Charter section 16.
