QUESTION PRESENTED

You have asked for a legal opinion concerning City of San Diego firefighte

During this period of time, the designated firefighters rem employees for all purposes including eligibility for industrial disability This is not an unusual arrangement and is similar to the situation when Cit are activated under a mutual aid agreement pursuant to California Governmen seq. Therefore, employees in this status are entitled to all of the benefi industrial disability retirement benefits.
