Division 26: Rebates by Purveyors of Goods, Supplies, Services — Unlawful

§33.2602 Rebates Prohibited

For the better protection and preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City and its inhabitants, it shall be unlawful for any purveyor, directly or indirectly, to pay or give, permit or cause to be paid or given, or offer to pay or give to any person, or for any person, directly or indirectly to request, receive or accept from any purveyor any sum of money, credit or other valuable considerations as a commission, discount or gratuity for recommending or procuring a service of such purveyor for any other person, or directing patronage or clientele to such purveyor, or influencing any person to refrain from using or utilizing a service of any other purveyor.
