§42.0101 Purpose

Health regulated businesses include food facilities regulated in the California Retail Food Code California Health and Safety Code sections 113700 et seq. (CRFC), which provides Statewide health and sanitation standards for retail food facilities. The CRFC allows a city or county to establish some local requirements for retail food facilities and their employees. The CRFC also provides that a local enforcement agency shall have primary enforcement responsibility for the State regulations in its jurisdiction. The purposes of this Division are to adopt regulations for retail food facilities and their employees in addition to the CRFC and applicable City regulations for health regulated businesses to protect the public health and safety in the City and to appoint the San Diego County Department of Environmental Health as the local enforcement authority on State and County regulations for retail food facilities and their employees in the City.
