(RA-2006-114)

Resolution authorizing the Agency Executive Director or designee, to:

- Item 1. Apply to CalHFA for a HELP Program Loan of up to \$1.5 Million and,

- Item 2. Upon award of such funds, to:
 - a. Executive loan agreements
 - b. Commit Redevelopment Agency resources to repay the loan
 - c. Take other actions necessary to facilitate the proposed program.
