Authorize the Agency Executive Director, or designee, to expend over three years from the date of execution of the Agreement up to \$2,700,000, with up to \$900,000 to be the expenditure for the first year, in City Heights tax increment housing setaside funds for individual second mortgage loans to first-time homebuyers in the City Heights Redevelopment Project Area and City Heights Community Planning Area, provided that City Comptroller furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds necessary for expenditure area, or will be on deposit, in the City Treasury.
