- Item 3. Authorizes the Agency Executive Director or designee to execute the construction contract with west coast general corporation for construction of the project in the amount of \$8,346,935 upon satisfaction of requirements;
- Item 4. Authorizes the Centre City Development Corporation ("Corporation"), on behalf of the Agency, to enter into an agreement with Railpros, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$1,237,238, for construction-related services;
