Time allotted to each speaker is determined by the Chair and, in general, is limited to three (3) minutes; moreover, collective testimony by those who support or oppose an item shall be limited to no more than fifteen (15 minutes to per side).

Members of the public wishing to address the Agency must submit a “Request to Speak” form to the City Clerk **prior** to the agenda item being called. Please note that “Request to Speak” forms will **not** be accepted once the item is called. Speaker slip on any item should be submitted at the **beginning** of each Agency meeting.

Informational Item

1. **Downtown Public Restrooms-East Village and Little Italy Districts of the Expansion Sub Area of the Centre City Redevelopment Project Area (District 2)**

That the Agency provide direction regarding the following strategy for public restrooms downtown:

- Item 1. Research and gather additional public input on the location of public restrooms in East Village and develop a maintenance funding strategy; and
- Item 2. Develop a design and bid package to site two Portland Loos or equivalent in Little Italy, with maintenance provided by the Little Italy Association.

At this time, staff is seeking direction from the Agency to proceed with further development of the public restrooms concept. If the public restrooms concept proceeds to bidding/construction, staff will return to the Agency for authorization and, at that time, it will be determined if CEQA review is needed. Consequently, this activity is not a "Project" under the definition set forth in CEQA Guidelines Section 15378. Therefore, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15060 (c)(3), the activity is not subject to CEQA.
