TUESDAY, APRIL 21, 1970

The Regular Redevelopment Agency Meeting was called to order by Deputy Chairman Loftin at 4:00 p.m.

Minutes of the Adjourned Regular Meeting of March 17, 1970 held March 24, 1970, were presented by the Deputy Secretary. On motion of Member Cobb, seconded by Member Martinet, said Minutes were approved without reading, after which they were signed.

Jim Spotts, Project Director, presented an oral report on the San Diego City College Redevelopment Project.

Deputy City Attorney Kronberger answered questions from the Council.

RESOLUTION 13, approving the Owner Participation Rules in the San Diego City College Redevelopment Project; directing the Executive Director to make said Rules available for public inspection, was adopted on motion of Member Landt, seconded by Member Martinet.

A proposed resolution setting the time and place for a meeting of the Redevelopment Agency, was presented.

RESOLUTION 14, scheduling a regular meeting of the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego for 2:00 p.m., Tuesday, May 12, 1970, in the Council Chamber, 12th Floor, City Administration Building, was adopted on motion of Member Martinet, seconded by Member Cobb.


