

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE

A proposed Resolution, authorizing the advertising for bids for
demolition of structures in the City College Expansion Project, was

RESOLUTION 60, authorizing the advertising for bids for demolition
of structures in the City College Expansion Project, was adopted on

A proposed Resolution, authorizing an Agreement with
Darley/Gobar Associates, Inc. to conduct an economic and market
analysis of the Linda Vista Shopping Center, for the sum of \$9,000,
was presented.

Deputy Executive Director Moore, and Community Development
Director Simpson, answered questions directed by the Members.

RESOLUTION 61, authorizing an Agreement with Darley/Gobar
Associates, Inc. to conduct an economic and market analysis of the
Linda Vista Shopping Center, for the sum of \$9,000, was adopted
on motion of Member Morrow.


Mr. Jose Trejo, Deputy Model Cities Director, presented the Staff Report on the Model Cities Program.
