Item 3: Joint Meeting and Public Hearing to consider adoption of resolutions relating to the Final Master Environmental Impact Report (MEIR) for Centre City Redevelopment Projects as it pertains to the proposed Fifth Amendment to the Marina Redevelopment Plan; certifying the Agency's review of the MEIR; and approving and adopting the Marina Urban Design Plan and Development Guidelines as design standards for the Marina Project; amending the Streetscape Design Manual, Technical Supplement for the Horton Plaza, Columbia and Marina Projects; and approving the proposed Fifth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Marina Project.

Members Filner and Roberts requested that henceforth, the Agency be notified of all Board votes.
