She also distributed color photographs showing a model of One Pacific Plaza superimposed upon the existing downtown skyline, as requested at the August 7, 1990 meeting.

Motion by Filner to adopt the resolution.

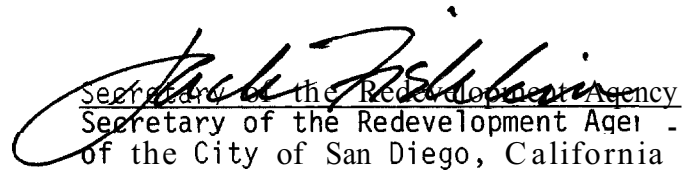
