

**ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING
OF
OCTOBER 30, 1990**

At 6:35 p.m., on a motion by Member Wolfsheimer, seconded by Member Hartley, the agenda was trailed to 2 p.m. on Wednesday, October 31, 1990 at 2:00 p.m. in the 12th floor Council Chambers. The vote to trail was 5-0 (Members Wolfsheimer, Hartley, Pratt, Bernhardt and Chair O'Connor voting in the affirmative.)

At 4:48 p.m. on Wednesday, October 31, 1990 the Adjourned Regular Meeting of October 30, 1990, trailed to 10/31/90, was called to order.

Item 2: Resolution adopting Policy No. 100-1 setting forth the Agency's intent for the use of Housing Setaside Funds.

Item 3: Resolution reaffirming the Agency's commitment to facilitate the creation, preservation and improvement of very-low-, low- and moderate-income housing; and providing a method by which housing setaside funds would be transferred to the Housing Trust Fund.

Kurt Chilcott gave the staff report on these two items. Member Pratt urged the establishment of a timetable for developing the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), asking it be brought back to the Agency in a timely manner.

Reynaldo PISAÑO, representing the Southeast Development Committee, spoke in opposition to Item No. 2.

Motion by Pratt to adopt Items 2 and 3.
Second by Roberts.
Vote: 7-0

Member Wolfsheimer left the meeting.

Item 4: Resolution approving a new agreement with Kane, Ballmer & Berkman for legal services for SEDC, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.

Vote: 6-0


