- Item 2. Authorize the City of San Diego's (City's) Chief Financial Officer, as delegated, to authorize to expend up to \$283, 576, to establish the necessary accounts, to appropriate and to allot all monies available for the project, and to carry forward any unexpended balance remaining in budgetary account at the end of each fiscal year into the next year as continuing appropriation, subject to amendment by the Agency;

- Item 5. Authorize the Agency Executive Director or designee, to execute the construction contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the construction and installation of the Improvements;
- Item 6. Authorize the Corporation, on behalf of the Agency, to administer the construction contract for the construction and installation of the Improvements.

Make certain findings that the proposed Project benefits the Project Area or the immediate neighborhood in which the Project Area is located, that no other reasonable means of financing is available to the community; that the payment of funds will assist in eliminating blighting conditions by improving the existing damaged and non-ADA-compliant public improvements to current City Standards, by removing sight obstructions and conditions that create policing and safety issues, and by insuring adequate health and safety facilities for the public inside the Project Area; and that the proposed Project is consistent with the Implementation Plan adopted for the Project Area pursuant to California Health and Safety Code section 33490 (Attachment B).
