On May 1, 2001, Susan Hamilton, Assistant Director of the Metropolitan Wastewater Department, will return from a one-year leave of absence to her job as Assistant Director of the Metropolitan Wastewater Department. On May 18, 2001, Dave Schlesinger, Director of the Metropolitan Wastewater Department, will retire after 11 years of outstanding service to the City of San Diego to begin a career in the private sector. Scott Tulloch has been appointed to serve as Acting Director of the Metropolitan Wastewater Department during the selection process for a permanent Director. Effective May 19, 2001, Scott will assume all the duties and responsibilities of the Director.

Scott Tulloch has been with the City for 7 years. He has been the Acting Assistant Director for the last year, and previous to that, he was the Deputy Director for Engineering and Program Management in the Metropolitan Wastewater Department since 1994. In this position he was responsible for execution of the Department's \$1.5 Billion Capital Improvement Program. Prior to working for the City, he completed a career in the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. He has a Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering from the Citadel, a Master of Science Degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Texas at Austin, and a Master of Arts Degree from the U.S. Naval War College. He is a registered Professional Civil Engineer in California.
