STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Authorize the reprogramming of CDBG funds.


SUMMARY: This action will reprogram CDBG funds for Council Districts 1,2,3,4,5,7,8 and Citywide. All Council District CDBG transfers listed in Attachment A are reprogrammed at the request of the respective Council member from each district. Some changes are the result of cancelled projects, project savings, projects that are not yet ready for funding or a change in priorities.

FISCAL CONSIDERATIONS: There is no impact to the General Fund from this action. Funds are available from the Community Development Block Grant Program.


PREVIOUS COUNCIL and/or COMMITTEE ACTION: FY 2008 CDBG Allocation; Council Action: May 8, 2007.
