<u>REQUESTED ACTION:</u> Review the City of San Diego FY 2014-2018 Five-Year Financial Outlook and forward to full City Council for discussion.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Approve the Requested Action.

<u>SUMMARY</u>: The City of San Diego FY 2014-2018 Five-Year Financial Outlook (Outlook) is a guiding document for long-range fiscal planning and provides the framework for the development of the City's annual budget. The Outlook incorporates a variety of economic assumptions and expenditure requirements that will likely influence projected revenues and appropriation needs over the next five years. The City's General Fund is the primary focus of the Outlook. The Outlook forecasts General Fund revenues and expenditures for five fiscal years beginning in FY 2014. The FY 2013 Adopted Budget serves as the baseline for developing the FY 2014-2018 revenue and expenditure forecast. The projected FY 2014 surplus in the FY 2014-2018 Five-Year Financial Outlook is \$4.9 million.
