

**Linda Vista Public Facilities Financing Plan 2004**  
**Linda Vista Community Planning Committee**  
**Supplementary Priority List**

The following items represent additional priorities and needs as identified and stated by the planning committee. Additional comments are also included to further communicate the desires of the planning committee. As projects not currently eligible for Development Impact Fee (DIF) funding, several projects are also listed here to express the planning committee's interest for funding the projects should additional funding sources be identified.

- The study and development of a “clover-leaf” ramp project coming under Tecolote Road and up to go West on Tecolote Road towards the freeway ramps. While outside of the Linda Vista community planning area, the planning committee will continue to work with the Clairemont Mesa Planning Committee, Council District 6, and city staff on this priority. The planning committee feels such a project could eliminate the need for project T-6 and any corresponding projects in the Clairemont Mesa Public Facilities Financing Plan 2002.
- The study and development of a project to realign Metro Street through to West Morena Boulevard.
- The study and development of a project to extend Sherman Street to Friars Road.
- At such a time that project L-1 is initiated, the community would like for staff and any project consultants to study the possibility of expanding the facility to also include a community center. The group also would like an expanded facility to be comparable in size to the new branch libraries being constructed.
- The committee wishes to emphasize the significance of park maintenance for all existing parks and future park projects. It is of great importance to the community to maintain such valuable public facilities.
- With respect to project T-6 and the communities proposed “clover-leaf” project, the community requests that the city also coordinate with Sea World and the timing of its required traffic mitigation improvement projects.
- With respect to projects T-15, T-16 and any others involving other agencies and contractors working on projects in the public right-of-way, the community requests that the City continue to coordinate such project schedules to minimize repeated disturbances to the community, it's roadways and utilities.
- The committee further notes that all projects affecting the ingress and egress to the Linda Vista community are to be considered community priorities.
