

MILESTONES IN CURRENT REVISION EFFORT
COUNCIL POLICY 600-24
5/31/05

- May 2003 CPC meeting – Chair Dave Potter announces a CPC subcommittee to review possible modifications to Council Policy 600-24 [CP600-24]
- August 1, 2003 - Kathryn Burton provides staff with CPC's issues regarding CP600-24
- August 8, 2003 – 1st meeting of CPC subcommittee where 8/1/03 issues are expanded upon and new CPC issues are identified.
- September – October 2003 – CPC subcommittee works with staff on the “Elections Handbook” concurrently with work on CP600-24.
- September 19, 2003 - begins regular series of meetings on CP600-24 to identify issues; review and revise proposed language changes for 18 CPC-identified issues for revision and 36 Planning-identified issues for revision.
- Staff begins parallel review and revisions of the Administrative Guidelines [that are used with CP600-24] to better reflect draft changes to CP600-24. First staff draft of proposed revisions to Administrative Guidelines produced in August 2004. CPC subcommittee reviews Administrative Guidelines and recommends revisions. Final review pending.
- October 15, 2004 – CPC subcommittee meeting to incorporate any pre-distribution comments from subcommittee members.
- October 19, 2004 – CPC Subcommittee draft of revisions to CP600-24 distributed to CPC members and posted on Planning's website.
- October 26, 2004 – CPC votes to distribute CPC subcommittee draft to all planning groups for individual group review.
- November 3, 2004 – report published to Land Use and Housing Committee indicating planning groups' review of CP600-24 revisions.
- February 18, 2005 – CPC subcommittee met to review all comments received from planning groups' review. Minor revisions to CP600-24 draft per CPC subcommittee review.
- March 1, 2005 – proposed revisions to CP600-24 distributed to CPC and posted to Planning Department's website for planning groups' and public review.
- March 22, 2005 – CPC vote in support 15-2-1.
- June 15, 2005 - Land Use and Housing Committee meeting.
- Future Action: City Council hearing. CPC subcommittee to continue review of Administrative Guidelines.
