# NOTICE OF PROPOSED WORK FOR A COASTAL EMERGENCY DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT

This is to inform you that the Development Services Department Staff will make a decision to approve, conditionally approve, modify or deny an Emergency Coastal Development Permit application within the Coastal Overlay Zone for the emergency repairs to a large void under approximately 360 feet of existing pedestrian walkway created from eroded rock formation as a result of repeated tidal action which continued to wash away the concrete steps, fill, and rock material located along the coastal bluff at the end of Narragansett Avenue (5100 block) and west of the Silver Spray apartments. Note – any approval for emergency development requires the subsequent processing of a standard Coastal Development Permit application for any work authorized on an emergency basis.
