

RESOLUTION NO. 186076

To improve 31st Street and Redwood Street; to improve and construct drainage structures in Quince Street and the Alley in Block 9, Frary Heights, and establish the official grade in the Alley in Block 9, Frary Heights.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the plans, drawings, typical cross-sections, profiles and specifications for:

Grading, paving, constructing drainage structures, changing the official grade and otherwise improving 31ST STREET, between the southerly line of Redwood Street and the southerly line of Quince Street; REDWOOD STREET, at its intersection with 31st Street; QUINCE STREET, between the easterly line of 31st Street and a line parallel to and distant 180 feet westerly therefrom; and the ALLEY IN BLOCK 9, FRARY HEIGHTS, from 31st Street westerly 210'±, and streets intersecting therewith,

in said City, as prepared by the City Engineer of The City of San Diego and filed in the office of the City Clerk of said City on December 30, 1965, under Document No. 694332,

be, and the same are hereby approved and adopted as the official plans, drawings, typical cross-sections, profiles and specifications for said work and improvement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that that certain Plat No. 3694, showing the exterior boundaries of the district to be included in the assessment for the work and improvement upon the said street(s) hereinabove mentioned, be, and the same is hereby approved; and the City Clerk of said City, upon the passage of the Resolution of Intention for said improvement, is hereby directed to file said plat in the office of the City Engineer of said City.
