

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 186412
PACIFIC HIGHWAY

STREET LIGHTING OPERATION DISTRICT NO. 1

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Council of The City of San Diego, that the report of the City Engineer preparatory to creating the _____
PACIFIC HIGHWAY _____ STREET LIGHTING
OPERATION DISTRICT No. 1, dated January 10, 1966, is approved
and shall be kept on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 696368.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council, finding that the public interest and convenience so requires, proposes and intends to order the following improvement to be made in said City under the provisions of Sections 65.02 to 65.12, inclusive, of the San Diego Municipal Code, to-wit:

The furnishing of electric energy for the lighting of the ornamental street lights located on or along the following public ways in The City of San Diego.

PACIFIC HIGHWAY, between the northerly line of Broadway as it now exists and the southwesterly prolongation of the southeasterly line of Vine Street.

Reference is made to Exhibit 1 of said Report of the City Engineer for a general description of the lighting system to be operated.

The proposed cost of energy and estimated incidental expenses for the operation of the system for the two years for which the proposed district shall be assessed is \$ 8,241.07. Reference is made to Exhibit 3 of said Report of the City Engineer, for a statement of the proposed assessments.

The following is a general description of the boundaries of the district to be benefited by and to be assessed to pay the costs for the energy to be furnished to the lighting system.

The district extends from Broadway on the south to Vine Street on the north, and includes all property with frontage on both the west and east sides of Pacific Highway.

Such furnishing of electric energy shall be for a period of two years from and including November 1, 1965, to and including October 31, 1967; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Tuesday, MAR 29 1966, at ^{9:00}~~10:00~~ o'clock A.M., in the Council Chamber on the 12th Floor of the City Administration Building, Community Concourse, 202 "C" Street, City of San Diego, be, and the same are hereby appointed as the time and place for hearing protests of any person having any interest in lands within the district liable to be assessed for the costs of the lighting operation. Any of said persons may present any objections that they may have to the proposed operation, to the awarding of a contract to the public utility, or to the proposed assessment, by written protests filed with the City Clerk, at or before the time set for the hearing.
