

RESOLUTION ORDERING WORK NO. 185926

To improve and construct drainage structures in Raejean Avenue, Murray Canyon Road, Public Right of Way in Pueblo Lots 1173, 1182, 1186 and 1187, Cable Road Addition, and Lot 130, Princess Park Estates Unit No. 5; and establish the official grade on Raejean Avenue.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That the Council hereby orders the following work to be done and improvement to be made, to-wit:

All the street work and improvement described in Resolution of Intention No. 185623,

adopted by the Council on November 30, 19 65, and on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City, for

The grading, paving, constructing drainage structures, establishing the official grade and otherwise improving RAEJEAN AVENUE, MURRAY CANYON ROAD, and PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY in PUEBLO LOTS 1173, 1182, 1186 and 1187, CABLE ROAD ADDITION, and LOT 130, PRINCESS PARK ESTATES UNIT NO. 5, in the City of San Diego, California,

within the limits and as particularly described in said Resolution.

For a particular description of the work reference is hereby made to said Resolution of Intention.

The costs and expenses of said work and improvement are to be assessed upon the district which is more particularly described in said Resolution of Intention.

The said Council determined that serial bonds extending over a period ending nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the next September 1st following their date, bearing interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, shall be issued to represent assessments of fifty dollars or more for the expenses of said work and improvement, as provided by the Improvement Act of 1911, and amendments thereto.

For further particulars, reference is hereby made to said Resolution of Intention.

The Purchasing Agent of said City is hereby directed to post conspicuously for five (5) days, on or near the Council Chamber door of said Council, in the manner and form required by law, a notice, together with a copy of the prevailing wage schedule established by Resolution No. 185322, adopted by said Council on the

26 day of October, 19 65, all of which is more particularly set forth in the Resolution of Intention, inviting sealed proposals or bids for doing the work ordered; and said Purchasing Agent is hereby directed to publish twice in The San Diego Union, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City, and hereby designated for that purpose by said Council, a notice inviting such proposals for doing the said work, and referring to the specifications and prevailing wage schedule on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City.
