

# RESOLUTION No. 185960

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of said City, an agreement with the State of California, Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, for the modification of traffic signals on 40th Street (State Highway Route 103) at the intersections of Meade Avenue, Orange Avenue and University Avenue, in the City of San Diego, California, under the terms and conditions set forth in the form of agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 694577.

2. That the expenditure of \$20,500 is hereby authorized out of Gas Tax Fund 220 of the City of San Diego, solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for said modification of traffic signals on 40th Street (State Highway Route 103) at the intersections of Meade Avenue, Orange Avenue and University Avenue.
