

RESOLUTION NO. 185995

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego has heretofore entered into a contract with Sim J. Harris Company for the improvement of 35th Street, between Boston and Newton Avenues, on work being done pursuant to the Improvement Act of 1911 proceeding; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the work required by the contract, it will be necessary to do the following work:

8 cu. yds. excavation
450 sq. ft. subgrade preparation
450 sq. ft. 4" cement treated base; and

WHEREAS, the contractor will perform the additional work for the sum of \$113.00, and the City Manager has recommended that it be authorized to do the work; and


WHEREAS, the contract for the 35th Street project is \$5,971.68; and

WHEREAS, California Streets and Highways Code, Section 5236, provides that the Council may, after construction has begun, order changes in the work of an Improvement Act of 1911 project without the necessity of further hearings so long as the amount of any change does not exceed \$500 when the total amount of the contract does not exceed \$50,000; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:


That the City Manager be, and he is hereby authorized to employ Sim J. Harris Company to do the work hereinabove particularly described in addition to the work shown on the improvement plans for 35th Street, between Boston and Newton Avenues, the cost of the work not to exceed the sum of \$113.00, which sum shall be assessed to the 35th Street assessment district (Resolution of Intention No. 184175).
