

RESOLUTION NO. 185997

WHEREAS, the City Council, in the Annual Appropriation Ordinance adopted July 1, 1965, authorized the Economic Research Bureau to conduct an Economic Development Survey of San Diego County to be jointly financed by the City, County, and Chamber of Commerce, the purpose of this survey as set forth in the budget document being to inventory, evaluate, and mobilize all of the natural, physical, economic, and human resources of the County to enable private and public agencies more accurately to define their economic objectives; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by Resolution No. 184553 on August 10, 1965, authorized the City Manager on behalf of the City to enter into an agreement with the Chamber of Commerce for the Economic Research Bureau to conduct such a survey which would culminate in an economic base study, an analysis of the economy, and a recommended program for securing the area's economy; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is statistically eligible for designation as a redevelopment area under the Public Works and Economic Development Act of 1965, which Act provides for public works facility grants, loans to local government for development facilities, loans to private business under favorable terms, and technical assistance grants to identify and develop the potentials of redevelopment areas; and

WHEREAS, to establish eligibility under the Act there is required to be filed with the U. S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration, an Overall Economic Development Program for the area, such program to be developed by a local agency broadly representative of the area's economy;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego:
That the organization structure created by the Economic Research

Bureau for the conduct of the Economic Development Survey, consisting of a Steering Committee, an Advisory Committee, and a Technical Committee, be designated as the agency authorized by the City to promulgate and file with the Department of Commerce an Overall Economic Development Program for the area.
