

RESOLUTION OF AWARD NO. 186148

To improve and construct drainage structures in Genesee Avenue and Public Rights of Way; to improve Appleton Street, Lehrer Drive and Governor Drive; and establish the official grade on Genesee Avenue.

RESOLVED, that the Council of The City of San Diego, California, having in open session on the 13th day of January, 1966, accepted the Purchasing Agent's report on bids or sealed proposals City Purchasing Dept., 3rd floor, Conference room, which were opened, examined, and publicly declared in the ~~Council Chamber~~ on the 12th day of January, 1966, for the following work to be done and improvements to be made in said City.

All the street work and improvement described in the Resolution of Intention No. 185508 adopted as amended by Resolution No. 185800, adopted Dec. 21, 1965, by the Council on November 16, 1965, and on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City, for

The grading, paving, constructing drainage structures, establishing the official grade, and otherwise improving GENESEE AVENUE, PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY in PUEBLO LOTS 1242, 1248, 1249 and 1272; LOTS 373, 374, 392 and 393, Heritage Addition, Unit No. 4; LOTS 443 and 444, Heritage Addition, Unit No. 5; and LOT 2, University City Service Station Site; APPLETON STREET, LEHRER DRIVE, and GOVERNOR DRIVE, in the City of San Diego, California,

within the limits and as particularly described in said Resolution. For a particular description of the work reference is hereby made to said Resolution of Intention.

The costs and expenses of said work and improvement are to be assessed upon the district which is more particularly described in said Resolution of Intention.

The said Council determined that serial bonds extending over a period ending nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the next **September 1st** following their date, bearing interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, shall be issued to represent assessments of fifty dollars or more for the expenses of said work and improvement, as provided by the Improvement Act of 1911, and amendments thereto.

For further particulars, reference is hereby made to said Resolution of Intention.

Said Council hereby rejects all of said proposals or bids except herein mentioned and hereby awards the contract for said work and improvement to the lowest regular responsible bidder to-wit _____

GRIFFITH COMPANY at the prices named in its bid for said work which is on file in the office of the City Clerk of The City of San Diego, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars.

The City Clerk of said City is hereby directed to cause a notice of this award to be published twice in the San Diego Union, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City and hereby designated for that purpose by said Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause a notice of this award of contract to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of San Diego County pursuant to the provisions of Section 5248 of the Streets and Highways Code.
