

RESOLUTION NO. 186272

WHEREAS, it is necessary to employ the services of a private attorney to render a bonding opinion in connection with the San Diego Improvement District Procedural Ordinance proceedings for the development of the Bird Rock Shore Protection Project; and

WHEREAS, Franklin T. Hamilton has agreed to give this bonding opinion and has agreed that he will not hold The City of San Diego responsible for the fee in the event that the assessment is not levied;

Hamilton to the City Attorney's office, a form of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 695883.
