WHEREAS, this Council has granted a petition for the construction of a protective sea wall in the Bird Rock Shores area; and

WHEREAS, a resolution of intention has been adopted declaring that the City intends to participate in the construction of such a sea wall pursuant to the provisions of the San Diego Improvement District Procedural Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, an urgent need exists for the construction of the sea wall in order to conserve and protect the properties within the assessment district; and

WHEREAS, the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers requires that the funds representing the City and the assessment district's share of this project be forwarded to the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers before it commences design of the project; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Improvement District Procedural Ordinance provides that the City may advance funds representing the proposed assessment, said funds to be reimbursed to the City upon any collection of the assessments either in cash or through the sale of bonds; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That an urgent need exists for the improvement of the Bird Rock Shores area by the construction of a protective sea wall and that the City therefore advance to the State of California (Department of Water Resources) for the delivery of the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers the monies held for this purpose under Resolution No. 184095.
