

RESOLUTION NO. 186461

WHEREAS, the San Diego Zoological Society has planned extensive celebration and promotion of the event; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego will greatly be benefited by the planned publicity; and

WHEREAS the Transient Occupancy Tax is to be used for promotion of the City of San Diego, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the sum of \$25,000 be pledged to the San Diego Zoo's 50th Anniversary celebration, such funds when paid to be allocated from the Transient Occupancy Tax, of the 1966-1967 budget; and further, that the sum of \$25,000 will be used to promote The City of San Diego in conjunction with the 50th Anniversary of the San Diego Zoo.
