

RESOLUTION NO. 186512

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ADOPTING AND SUBMITTING A BUDGET FOR EXPENDITURE OF STATE ALLOCATED (ENGINEERING) FUNDS.


WHEREAS, a Master Agreement for the Budgeting and Expenditure of the Engineering Allocation under Section 2107.5 of the Streets and Highways Code has been entered into by The City of San Diego, hereinafter referred to as "City," and the State Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, hereinafter referred to as "Department"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has prepared a budget proposal showing estimated expenditures of such funds recommended to be made during the 1966-67 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has heard read said budget proposal and is familiar with the contents thereof; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That said budget proposal dated March 3, 1966, be and it is hereby adopted as the budget of proposed expenditures of the State allocated funds for engineering to cities, said budget proposal to be and the same is hereby approved and the City Manager is directed to sign the same on behalf of said City, and said budget proposal shall be submitted to the Department of Public Works, State of California, in accordance with the provisions of Section 197 of the Streets and Highways Code.
