AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 18 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 22.1801 CREATING A NEW DEPARTMENT OF FACILITIES AND RENAMING THE PARKS AND PUBLIC FACILITIES DEPARTMENT AND THE UTILITIES DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 2, Division 18 of the San Diego Municipal Code, be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 22.1801 to read as follows:

SEC. 22.1801 CITY DEPARTMENTS
