AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 12666 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1979-80," BY AMENDING EXHIBIT C AND ADDING EXHIBIT C-1 THERETO TO CREATE VARIOUS UNCLASSIFIED CLASSES IN THE MANAGERIAL CATEGORY AND ESTABLISH A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the voters approved an amendment to Charter Section 117 in November, 1979, as Proposition E to provide for the conversion of certain administrative positions from the Classified to the Unclassified Service; and

WHEREAS, the amendment provides that those positions shall include "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs"; and

WHEREAS, the amendment provides further that each such position so identified "shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, each of the classifications recommended previously have been determined to meet the "Employee-Management" definition of the City's Employer-Employee Relations Policy and, as a result, are not contained in any of the represented bargaining units; and

WHEREAS, the present action does not encompass all possible non-represented positions for conversion but only extends to twenty-one classifications with sixty-six positions; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission on January 11, 1980 reviewed this proposed action and forwarded its comment by separate memorandum in support of the recommended classes; and

WHEREAS, the conversion from Classified to Unclassified Service for the classes enumerated hereinafter is now deemed necessary and proper pursuant to the intent and authority of Proposition E; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 12666 (New Series), as amended, entitled, "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1979-80," is hereby further amended by creating various unclassified classes in three groups in the Managerial category, as more specifically enumerated and set forth in Attachment 1 hereto as an amendment to and to be added to Exhibit C of Ordinance No. 12666 (New Series), as amended.

Section 2. As a schedule of compensation for the unclassified positions created in Section 1 hereof, the salary rates set forth in the Pay Table for Managerial Classes, identified as Exhibit C-1 and attached hereto as Attachment 2, is hereby adopted.

Section 3. The monthly rates set forth in Exhibit C-1, Pay Table for Managerial Classes, are calculated and established at \$50 and \$60 per month step differentials for informational



and comparative purposes only. All references to step increases of \$50 and \$60 per month are and shall be deemed to mean approximations thereof. The Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to develop and establish appropriate calculations and tables to most closely approximate on an hourly and biweekly basis the schedule of compensation established and set forth in Exhibit C-1.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 12666 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1979-80," BY AMENDING EXHIBIT C AND ADDING EXHIBIT C-1 THERETO TO CREATE VARIOUS UNCLASSIFIED CLASSES IN THE MANAGERIAL CATEGORY AND ESTABLISH A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION THEREFOR.
This ordinance amends the annual salary ordinance to carry out the provisions of Proposition E on the November, 1979, ballot, which amended Section 112 of the Charter of The City of San Diego. The amendment provided that certain positions in the Classified Service determined to be of managerial rank may, by ordinance of the City Council, be converted to Unclassified Service status. This action identifies and converts twenty-one classifications to Unclassified status and establishes a schedule of compensation for those classes.
