

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 18786 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON APR 10 2000

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 6,
DIVISION 7, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY
AMENDING SECTION 26.0702 RELATING TO THE
COMMISSION FOR ARTS AND CULTURE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 6, Division 7, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending section 26.0702, to read as follows:

SEC. 26.0702 Commission for Arts and Cultural Established

There is hereby established a Commission for Arts and Culture consisting of fifteen (15) members. Commission members shall be persons who represent the following areas: individual arts, arts organizations, arts patrons, educators, the business community, and the general public.

The members shall serve three (3) year staggered terms for a maximum of six (6) years and each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed. Effective May 1, 2000 and for all appointments thereafter, members shall serve two (2) year staggered terms for a maximum of eight (8) consecutive years, and each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed. An interval of four (4) years must pass before such persons can be reappointed. The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council, subject to the following conditions: 1) The Mayor shall appoint seven (7) members; and, 2) the Mayor shall appoint the remaining eight (8) members, one each from a list of three (3) nominations submitted by each Councilmember. The expiration date of all terms shall be August 31. During September of each year, the Mayor may designate one (1) member as chairperson; however, in the absence of such designation, the Commission shall on or after

October 15 select from their members a chairperson. The Commission shall meet not less than monthly and report to the Mayor and Council on an as needed basis, but not less than one time per year.

The Commission shall adopt rules consistent with laws for the government of its business and procedures.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

During September of each year, the Mayor may

designate one (1) member as chairperson; however, in the absence of such designation, the Commission shall on or after October 15 select from their members a chairperson. The Commission shall meet not less than monthly and report to the Mayor and Council on an as needed basis, but not less than one time per year.

The Commission shall adopt rules consistent with laws for the government of its business and procedures.
