DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE SEP 18 2018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING TWO PROGRAM COORDINATOR
POSITIONS IN THE OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY
FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE CITY OF SAN
DIEGO.

WHEREAS, on July 5, 2018, the City of San Diego (City)'s Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the Office of Homeland Security to exempt two Program Coordinator positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the first Program Coordinator will oversee and coordinate the statewide Preventing Violent Extremism Program and associated security strategies for the City; coordinate a multi-jurisdictional network to identify challenges and best practices for prevention and intervention programs and raise awareness for resources available to communities; assist with developing and updating the San Diego Urban Area Security Strategy that outlines the region's risks, capability needs, structure, and objectives for homeland security; develop strategic goals and objectives for the capabilities planning model; oversee, develop, and submit assessments, data, and inputs related to information pertaining to risks and threats, and supervise and oversee City risk management/threat analysis programs and procedures; and

WHEREAS, the second Program Coordinator will oversee the Urban Area Security Training (UASI) Program to include making decisions that have regional implications such as determining jurisdictional participation in regional training/exercises and negotiating training contracts; lead the UASI Regional Training Committee responsible for determining gaps and deficiencies in regional training and reviewing exercises and regional incidents; manage and administer the multi-year training and exercise plan to accomplish the priorities described in the

UASI Strategy; coordinate regional and citywide emergency preparedness training and exercises and ensure compliance with federal and state requirements; and oversee and develop City emergency plans, protocols, and procedures; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter (Charter) section 117(a)(17) states that the Unclassified Service shall include “[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council”; and

WHEREAS, on July 5, 2018, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Program Coordinator positions, as provided by the Office of Homeland Security, the Civil Service Commission determined that the Program Coordinator positions meet the standard set forth in Charter section 117(a)(17) to be placed in the Unclassified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding of the Civil Service Commission is set forth in a memorandum dated July 12, 2018, from Douglas Edwards, Personnel Director, to the Honorable Council President and City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:


Section 1. That the Council has received and reviewed a Memorandum from Personnel Director Douglas Edwards, dated July 12, 2018, which documents that, on July 5, 2018, the City’s Civil Service Commission reviewed and favorably commented on a proposal from the Office of Homeland Security to exempt from the City’s Classified Service two Program Coordinator positions in the Office of Homeland Security; the first will oversee and coordinate the statewide Preventing Violent Extremism Program and associated security strategies for the City; the second will oversee the Urban Area Security Training Program.

Section 2. That pursuant to Charter section 117(a)(17), with the Civil Service Commission's review and approval, the Council now exempts from the Classified Service and declares to be in the Unclassified Service of the City two Program Coordinator positions in the Office of Homeland Security, performing the duties set forth in the July 12, 2018, Memorandum from Personnel Director Douglas Edwards to the Honorable Council President and City Council.

Section 3. That a full reading of this Ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.

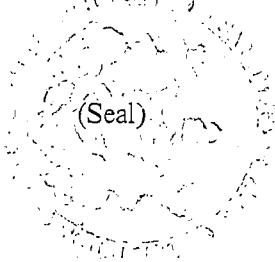
