DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 11 2019

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS WITH ALLAN  
COMPANY AND EDCO DISPOSAL CORPORATION FOR  
PROCESSING, TRANSPORTING, AND MARKETING  
COMMINGLED CURBSIDE RECYCLABLES.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego's (City) Environmental Services Department provides a comprehensive residential curbside recycling program to divert household recyclables from the City's waste stream; and

WHEREAS, the City requires the continued services of a contractor to process, transport, and market the recyclable materials collected in the City's curbside recycling program; and

WHEREAS, on April 2, 2019, the City issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 10089546-19-V for processing, transporting, and marketing the City's commingled curbside recyclables; and

WHEREAS, City staff determined that the Site proposed by Cedarwood-Young Company dba Allan Company (Allan Company) and two of the Sites proposed by EDCO Disposal Corporation, in response to the RFP, were responsive, responsible and deliver the best value to the City; and

WHEREAS, the proposed agreements with Allan Company and EDCO Disposal Corporation for processing, transporting, and marketing the City's commingled curbside recyclables (Agreements) are each for a term of seven (7) years, plus up to three (3) one (1) year optional extensions; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement, or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:


Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, the Agreements with Allan Company and EDCO Disposal Corporation for processing, transporting, and marketing the City's commingled curbside recyclables in an amount not to exceed \$65 million, total for both Agreements, for a term of seven (7) years with three (3) one (1) year options, exercise of which may be approved by the Mayor, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreements on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Documents No. OO- 21092-1 and No. OO- 21092-2

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$65 million from Fund 700048, Recycling Fund, over the full term of the Agreements, including the three (3) one (1) year options, for the purpose of funding the Agreements with Allan Company and EDCO Disposal Corporation, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriations Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.


