A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND EXPENDITURE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORTATION PLANNING GRANT FUNDS FOR THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO MOBILITY EVALUATION TOOL FOR ESTIMATING VEHICLE MILES TRAVELED AND TRAVEL DEMAND MANAGEMENT EFFECTIVENESS.

WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has established the Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant Program to support Caltrans' mission to provide a safe, sustainable, integrated and efficient transportation system to enhance California's economy and livability; and

WHEREAS, grant funding is intended to support and implement Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) Sustainable Communities Strategies (SCS) and to ultimately achieve statewide greenhouse gas (GHG) reduction targets of 40 and 80 percent below 1990 levels by 2030 and 2050, respectively; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) desires to develop the City of San Diego Mobility Evaluation Tool for Estimating Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT) and Travel Demand Management (TDM) Effectiveness, which will be a web-based, locally validated, quick-response planning tool to calculate how TDM and active transportation infrastructure reduces VMT on State and local roadways, a critical component to achieving GHG reduction goals in the City's Climate Action Plan (2015), the 2050 RTP/SCS (San Diego Association of Governments, 2015), and statewide GHG reduction targets; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego Mobility Evaluation Tool for Estimating VMT and
TDM Effectiveness will streamline the process for implementing housing in locations with

access to jobs, services and mobility options by integrating land use and transportation planning;

support the City's implementation of Senate Bill 743, which changed the metric for evaluating

California Environmental Quality Act transportation impacts to VMT; and provide valuable

information to planning staff, stakeholders, transportation planners and engineers, and the public;

and

WHEREAS, Caltrans notified the City on June 18, 2020, that the grant application for the

development of the City of San Diego Mobility Evaluation Tool for Estimating VMT and TDM

Effectiveness was selected for funding in the amount of \$221,325; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his

designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to secure funding for an amount not to

exceed \$221,325 in Caltrans Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant funds for the City of San

Diego Mobility Evaluation Tool for Estimating VMT and TDM Effectiveness, including but not

limited to executing all Restricted Grant Agreements and any amendments thereto with Caltrans.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept,

appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$221,325 for the City of San Diego Mobility

Evaluation Tool for Estimating VMT and TDM Effectiveness.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish

a special interest-bearing account for the grant funds, if necessary.
