ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 21321 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUN 14 2021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO SETTING ASIDE A CERTAIN PORTION OF DEDICATED CITY PARKLAND, COMMONLY KNOWN AS MIRA MESA OPEN SPACE, FOR THE OPENING AND MAINTENANCE OF A CITY STREET PURSUANT TO SAN DIEGO CHARTER SECTION 55.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is the owner of 6.76 acres of land in the Mira Mesa community, commonly known as Mira Mesa Open Space, which was dedicated for park and recreation purposes on November 30, 2012 (Dedicated Parkland), pursuant to Resolution No. R-307902 and amended on January 2, 2013 pursuant to Resolution No. R-307952 and San Diego Charter section 55; and

WHEREAS, Charter section 55 provides that, whenever the City Manager recommends it, and the City Council finds that the public interest demands it, the City Council may, without a vote of the people, authorize the opening and maintenance of streets and highways over, through, and across City fee-owned land which has been formally dedicated in perpetuity by ordinance or statute for park, recreation, and cemetery purposes; and

WHEREAS, Article XV of the Charter transfers to the elected Mayor all executive powers, duties, and responsibilities previously held by the City Manager; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor now recommends that the public interest demands the opening and maintenance of a street over, through, and across that certain portion of the Dedicated Parkland, in order to complete certain street improvements on the East side of Camino Santa Fe which will increase traffic flow and increase driver and pedestrian safety; and

WHEREAS, the street improvements shall include, but not be limited to, widening the northbound approach on Camino Santa Fe south of Flanders Road to construct a dedicated right-

turn lane with a Class II bicycle lane, which includes asphalt pavement (5' road widening), curb and gutter, sidewalk, pedestrian ramp, landscaping, signing and striping, and necessary signal modifications; and

WHEREAS, that certain portion of the Dedicated Parkland affected by this ordinance is more particularly described in the legal description entitled 3Roots – Plats+Legals, comprised of a legal description and Engineer's Drawings No. 41581-B, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00-21321; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego (Council), as follows:

Section 1. That the Council hereby finds that the public interest demands the opening and maintenance of a street over, through, and across that certain portion of the City-owned 6.76 acres of land in the Mira Mesa community, commonly known as Mira Mesa Open Space (Dedicated Parkland), in order to complete the 3Roots Project No. 587128; that certain portion of the Dedicated Parkland is more particularly described in the document entitled 3Roots – Plats+Legals, comprised of a legal description and Engineer's Drawings No. 41581-B, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00-21321.

Section 2. That a full reading of this Ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.


