DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 27 2021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING A PROGRAM MANAGER
POSITION IN THE PARKS AND RECREATION
DEPARTMENT FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2021, the San Diego Civil Service Commission (Civil Service Commission) reviewed a request from the Parks and Recreation Department (Department) to exempt a Program Manager position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Program Manager position will be responsible for overseeing and implementing the Park Ranger Training Program to include in-service training plans and professional development; establishing park ranger policies and procedures; developing, implementing, and monitoring training and the operations of Citywide park ranger programs; providing interagency coordination with law enforcement agencies; developing and implementing safety programs, procedures, and guidelines; identifying training opportunities; assessing the operations of the Park Ranger Program in order to maximize service delivery to the community and work with Department management, local and regional entities, community groups, and law enforcement agencies on these efforts; researching and identifying programs to meet the needs of the community, as well as identifying opportunities for improvement and proposing changes to existing programs; implementing special events; and managing the Park Ranger Volunteer Program; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include “[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority

and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Program Manager position as described by the Department to the Civil Service Commission, the Civil Service Commission found it meets the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding of the Civil Service Commission is presented to the Council as set forth in the memorandum dated June 4, 2021 to the Honorable Council President and members of the Council, prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Parks and Recreation Department initiated advisory review and comment from the Civil Service Commission related to the proposed exemption of a Program Manager position from the Classified Service. On June 3, 2021, the Civil Service Commission reviewed the proposed exemption and commented favorably as meeting Charter section 117 criteria for placement of the position in the Unclassified Service. Having considered and reviewed the finding of the Civil Service Commission, as set forth in the memorandum dated June 4, 2021, to the Honorable Council President and members of the Council, prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, the Council now exempts from the Classified Service the Program Manager position identified in the memorandum by the Department, and declares the position to be in the Unclassified Service.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
