A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH GRAYBAR ELECTRIC COMPANY INC., FOR ELECTRICAL, LIGHTING, DATA COMMUNICATIONS, AND SECURITY PRODUCTS.

WHEREAS, multiple City departments require maintenance, repair, and operations (MRO) supplies, including safety supplies, janitorial chemicals, tools, hardware, and lighting components, to conduct their day-to-day operations; and

WHEREAS, it is advantageous for the City to enter into cooperative agreements for commodities used by several jurisdictions due to the purchasing power that they create; and

WHEREAS, the City's Purchasing Agent has certified in writing that the cooperative agreement for electrical, lighting, data communications, and security products awarded to Graybar Electric Company, Inc. by the City of Kansas City, Missouri meets the requirements set forth in San Diego Municipal Code section 22.3208; and

WHEREAS, Purchasing & Contracting expects City departments to purchase a total of approximately \$9 million in electrical, lighting, data communications, and security products from their respective budgets over the next five years, and City Council approval is required to exceed \$3 million in purchases from a contract pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code section 22.3206(d); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to execute an agreement with Graybar Electric Company, Inc., on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document

No. RR- 313563 , for the as-needed purchase of electrical, lighting, data communications, and security products through January 31, 2025.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$9,000,000 to provide funds to purchase as-needed electrical, lighting, data communications, and security products under the agreement with Graybar Electric Company, Inc., contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasury.
