A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A COOPERATIVE PROCUREMENT CONTRACT WITH GENUINE PARTS COMPANY D.B.A. NAPA INTEGRATED BUSINESS SOLUTIONS FOR FLEET AND FACILITY RELATED VENDOR MANAGED INVENTORY AND LOGISTICS MANAGEMENT SOLUTIONS.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego's Fleet Operations Department (Fleet Department) operates and maintains a fleet of over 4,500 vehicles and equipment to support all City of San Diego (City) services and is responsible for the maintenance, repair, acquisition, and replacement of the City's fleet; and

WHEREAS, the City requires parts and supplies for its broad variety of vehicles and equipment which includes cars, SUVs, vans, medium and heavy-duty trucks, off-road construction equipment, and miscellaneous equipment (trailers) in the City's fleet; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell issued Request for Proposal (RFP) Number 110520 for Fleet and Facility Related Vendor Managed Inventory and Logistics Management Solutions; and

WHEREAS, on December 23, 2020, based on the results of the competitive process, Sourcewell awarded a contract with Genuine Parts Company d.b.a. NAPA Integrated Business Solutions (NAPA) and executed the Fleet and Facility Related Vendor Managed Inventory and Logistics Management Solutions contract with NAPA, who was the highest ranked bidder; and

WHEREAS, the City's Purchasing Agent has certified in writing that the cooperative contract for Fleet and Facility Related Vendor Managed Inventory and Logistics Management Solutions meets the requirements set forth in San Diego Municipal Code section 22.3208. The contract is in the City's best interests; the contract is to the City's economic advantage; and the

contract was competitively awarded using a process that complies with the policies, rules, and regulations developed by the City Manager; and

WHEREAS, NAPA offers a comprehensive solution of productivity enhancing goods and services including vendor-managed inventory services, technician productivity improvements, administrative time and cost reduction, operational cost reduction, expert staffed parts room, national distribution infrastructure, reporting and technology, full fleet and enterprise software integration, 24/7 emergency services, and shop and classroom technician training;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a cooperative procurement contract with NAPA for Fleet and Facility Related Vendor Managed Inventory and Logistics Management Solutions for the City's fleet on an as-needed basis, in an amount not-to-exceed \$29,000,000, for a term extending through December 29, 2024, with an option to extend for one additional year, pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the Contract, on file with the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- **313631**.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$29,000,000 from Fleet Operations Operating Fund 720000, over the term of the Contract which includes the option to extend for one additional year, to purchase automotive parts and supplies, contingent upon adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance

for the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
