DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE DEC 17 2021

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO ADOPTING THE CLIMATE RESILIENT SD
PLAN.

WHEREAS, California Senate Bill 379 (SB 379) requires each local jurisdiction to review and update its General Plan Safety Element by January 1, 2022, to address applicable climate adaptation and resiliency strategies; and

WHEREAS, SB 379 requires a vulnerability assessment, a set of adaptation and resilience goals, policies and objectives, and a set of feasible implementation measures; and

WHEREAS, the Climate Resilient SD initiative includes an update to the City of San Diego's General Plan Public Facilities, Services, and Safety Element, which references the Climate Resilient SD Plan and is considered together with this Resolution, and is intended to meet SB 379's legislative requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Climate Resilient SD Plan is intended to improve the lives of the people that live, work, and visit the City of San Diego, while best preparing for a changing climate; and

WHEREAS, the Climate Resilient SD Plan includes a suite of goals, policies and strategies that have been shaped by public input, and the strategies included are intended to provide flexibility in implementation, to allow the City to adjust implementation with changing climate conditions, and to prioritize actions based on community needs; and

WHEREAS, the Climate Resilient SD Plan is informed by the completion of several vulnerability assessments that have been prepared to identify City exposure and vulnerability to climate change hazards. These assessments identified and analyzed the four primary hazards that will affect the City of San Diego: extreme heat, wildfire, changes in precipitation (flooding and drought), and sea level rise; and

WHEREAS, the plan is designed as a policy framework that provides for flexible implementation, which allows the City to prioritize implementation based upon the core benefits that are associated with each strategy. It is also designed so that it can be implemented in a way that best serves the City's communities, based on conditions at the time and place of strategy implementation, and prioritizes implementation where the vulnerabilities to climate change are the greatest and focuses on protecting those with the fewest resources available to adapt; and

WHEREAS, the Climate Resilient SD Plan also implements the Climate Action Plan Strategy 5—Resiliency, which called for the preparation of a climate adaptation and resiliency plan; and

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2021, the Planning Commission of the City of San Diego considered the Climate Resilient SD Plan, and pursuant to Planning Commission Resolution No. 5166-PC, the Planning Commission voted to recommend approval of the Climate Resilient SD Plan; and

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2021, the San Diego City Council (Council) held a public hearing for the purpose of considering the adoption of the Climate Resilient SD Plan; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the Council adopts the Climate Resilient SD Plan, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 313851.

2. That the Mayor or their designee is authorized to make minor administrative changes to the plan to achieve the vision of the Climate Resilient SD Plan.
