ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 21488 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 21 2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING ONE DEPUTY DIRECTOR POSITION, ONE PROGRAM MANAGER POSITION, AND ONE PROGRAM COORDINATOR POSITION IN THE ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2022, the Civil Service Commission of the City of San Diego (City) reviewed a request from the Environmental Services Department (Department) to exempt one Deputy Director position, one Program Manager position, and one Program Coordinator position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Director position will oversee the Clean San Diego Program, Citywide Solid Waste Code Enforcement, and the impoundment function associated with the new Sidewalk Vending Ordinance. This position will provide management oversight and ensure compliance with Senate Bill 946 and the Sidewalk Vending Ordinance; develop and implement inventory control procedures; develop staffing and operational plans, policies, and procedures; provide management oversight of the Clean San Diego Program which oversees homeless camp waste abatements; and manage the oversight of the Solid Waste Code Enforcement Program to enforce solid waste code violations; and

WHEREAS, the Program Manager position will assist the Collections Services Division with the implementation of Senate Bill 1383 related to the disposal of organic waste and provide oversight to the division's administrative and operational staff. This position will coordinate container assembly and distribution services; supervise a Program Coordinator position; support and manage personnel issues; and ensure compliance with all State and local mandates related to solid waste operations and Senate Bill 1383; and

WHEREAS, the Program Coordinator position will oversee the Collection Services Division's vehicle and packer trucks, the daily operations of the Miramar Place Operations Yard, and develop operational efficiencies. This position will coordinate the repair, maintenance, planning/purchase, retirements, and software/hardware integration of the packer and vehicle fleet; develop and implement standard operating procedures for new vehicle equipment; oversee modifications to improve all vehicle effectiveness; oversee related contracts; and oversee industrial regulatory compliance for the Miramar Place Operations Yard; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include “[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council”; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the positions, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found they meet the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated June 3, 2022 to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council (Council), prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21488; NOW,
THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Council exempts from the Classified Service the one Deputy Director position, one Program Manager position, and one Program Coordinator position described by the Department.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
