DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 21 2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING ONE ASSISTANT DEPUTY
DIRECTOR POSITION AND ONE PROGRAM MANAGER
POSITION IN THE STORMWATER DEPARTMENT FROM
THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2022, the Civil Service Commission of the City of San Diego (City) reviewed a request from the Stormwater Department (Department) to exempt one Assistant Deputy Director position and one Program Manager position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Assistant Deputy Director position will be responsible for overseeing the Operations Section of the Stormwater Operations Division. This position will provide oversight and management over the street sweeping program, channel maintenance program, pump station program, and stormwater compliance; set policy direction; ensure annual key performance indicators are met; perform compliance tracking and reporting; and implement and oversee all stormwater maintenance regulatory activities; and

WHEREAS, the Program Manager position will be responsible for overseeing the Department's Think Blue Educational Campaign. This position will educate, inform, and receive input from stakeholders on stormwater and other projects in their neighborhoods; perform outreach and education through coordinated media campaigns; redefine and develop additional public engagement policies and procedures; expand the Think Blue Program to engage with communities that have not traditionally participated in the public process; and develop a plan to educate and engage stakeholders regarding the Storm Drain Fee; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include “[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council”; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the positions, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found they meet the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated June 3, 2022 to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council (Council), prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-21500; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Council exempts from the Classified Service the one Assistant Deputy Director position and one Program Manager position described by the Department.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
